Students who wish to use a physical agenda/planner should purchase one.

All Spanish Classes

1. 1 Composition Book (*we would like students to have this specific size and type of notebook, NOT spiral-bound.* Please and thank you!)
2. Ear buds / headphones (an inexpensive pair to STAY in backpack for use at school; may purchase from teacher for \$1)
3. 1 Pocket folder
4. Choose 1: Small dry erase board OR thick page protector with white paper
5. Dry erase marker/s

General Office Supplies needed in class

1. Writing utensils (pencils, pens)
2. Highlighter
3. Good eraser
4. Choose 1: Markers, Crayons or Colored Pencils
5. Scissors (optional)

Divisions 1 & 2 Wellness

Clothing appropriate for participation in physical activity classes:

1. Sneakers/athletic shoes are necessary! Please wear a pair or bring them to school daily.
2. A T-shirt to change into
3. Jacket, hat and mittens for cooler weather outdoor activities

Other essential items needed:

1. DEODORANT for after class use
2. Water bottle
3. Writing utensils for Health class

Division 1 Arts and Humanities

1. 12 to 15 pocket folders
2. Notebook (for class notes)
3. 10+ pencils
4. 10+ pens
5. Two to five highlighters
6. Three packages of note cards (3" x 5")

Division 2 Arts and Humanities

1. 6-8 pocket folders OR a binder (for class work)
2. 10+ pencils
3. 10+ pens
4. 2-5 highlighters
5. 3 packages of note cards (3"x5")

Division 1 MST

1. 7-pocket accordion folder
2. One composition book (please not spiral bound)
3. Sharpened pencils/mechanical pencils/pens to last the year

Wish List (to be donated to classroom)

1. Tape (blue painter's tape, and clear tape in individual dispensers)
2. Paper (graph paper, lined paper)
3. Pencils
4. Zip-top quart or gallon bags

Division 2 MST

1. Two (2) Bound Composition Notebooks
2. A System for Organizing Handouts (choose ONE of the following):
 - a. A 3-ring binder with dividers (*At least 3 slots - Math, Science, Homework/Assessments*)
OR
 - b. An accordion folder (*At least 3 slots - Math, Science, Homework/Assessments*)
OR
 - c. Three (3) Heavy Duty Pocket Folders (*Math, Science, Homework/Assessments*)

3. Lined Notebook Paper
4. Graphing Notebook Paper
5. Ear Buds or Headphones (for computer activities)
6. Pencils, pens, and a few colored pencils and/or pens
7. A scientific calculator and extra batteries. (Students cannot use the calculator on their phones!)

Please note that your family has some choices; we recognize that a graphing calculator is a significant expense.

- **At minimum**, a scientific calculator is needed for Division 2 work. (We recommend the **TI-30SX, TI-36X, or Casio FX300 series**. Must have trigonometry functions, square/cube roots, etc.) Because we are increasingly using student laptops for graphing, a good scientific calculator will meet most needs for students in the Division 2 MST classroom.
- **Recommended:** A **TI-83 or TI-84** graphing calculator is used in some Division 3 MST courses and can provide students with some advantages when they take standardized tests (SAT/ACT/AP, etc.), since computer-based graphing technologies are not permitted in those settings. (Scientific calculators are also permitted in testing settings.) Used and older models are fine; the newest models offer much crisper graphics but have the same overall functionality.
